- Assist with day-to-day operational tasks on farm including animal handling, animal health and welfare and vehicles. Expected to participate safely and effectively in the workplace.

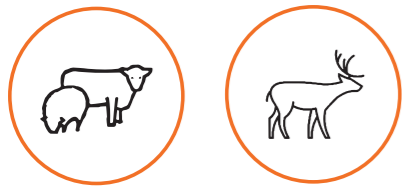
