GOOD MANAGEMENT PRACTICES FOR LATE SPRING

Fertiliser Application

- Only apply when conditions are suitable i.e. avoid times when soil temperature is too low.
- Don't apply when heavy rain is forecast.
- Keep well away from waterways.
- Avoid application to critical sources areas.
- Only apply fertiliser that can be used by the crop or pasture (test soils to check nutrient status).
- Little and often is better than lots now and then.
