The judges' decision will be final and no discussion will be entered into. The judges panel reserve the right not to judge an entry if it is deemed to be unsubstantiated.

Entrants agree to provide photos, stories or videos as required by Beef + Lamb New Zealand to promote the awards, winners and the sheep and beef sector.
