 **There are eight awards calling for nominations:**

### **AgResearch Emerging Achiever Award**

This award recognises those who are under 30 years and are working in the sheep and beef sector. They demonstrate future leadership/development potential and have already had a positive impact on the sector and/or their local community. This may be through involvement in the community and/or on-farm with new ideas and initiatives.

### **Rabobank People Development Award**

This award recognises a farmer or farming operation who deliver formal or informal people development opportunities through capability building and engagement of staff and/or trainees.

### **FMG Rural Champion Award**

This award recognises an individual or group whose contribution promotes the image of the sector to the wider community OR enhances the wellbeing of farmers and farming communities through their programmes and activities.

### **Alliance Significant Contribution Award**

This award recognises an outstanding individual who has led by example and has driven change in the operation and/or governance of the sheep and beef sector through new ideas, approaches and/or initiatives.

### **Silver Fern Farms Market Leader Award**

This award recognises a farmer or farming business demonstrating solutions, ideas or products which meet consumer needs either through partnership with their processor or direct to a market.

### **Datamars Livestock Technology Award**

This award recognises the development and implementation of a technology which solves a specific on-farm problem or need in the sheep and beef sector. This could include but is not limited to real-time monitoring on farm, software applications, satellite technologies, decision-making tools, GIS and automation.

### **Gallagher Innovative Farming Award**

This award recognises farmers and farming operations who are demonstrating outside-the-box thinking to develop new management systems, tools/products or processes that will benefit the farm business and could be applied more widely in the sector.

### **Ballance Agri-Nutrients Science and Research Award**

This award recognises excellence in science and research activities that are of direct relevance and benefit to the sheep and beef sector. This could include, but not limited to, animal health and welfare, advancements in agronomy, biodiversity enhancement, environmental science, data science, genetics and social science.
