



HOW TO: FINDING PHYSIOGRAPHIC ZONES FOR YOUR FARM


1. Go to maps & data on the Environment Southland website - <http://gis.es.govt.nz/landing.aspx>
2. Click on **Water and Land**




3. Make sure “**Physiographic Zones**” is ticked on the left-hand side.




4. **Zoom** into your property (Helpful hint - **alter the layer transparency** - lower left corner to lighten the physiographic zone layer which makes it easier to see map references and find your farm).




5. Print off a map of the physiographic zones on your property and add to your farm plan folder. Do this by either **clicking the 3 dots** in the top right hand corner of the screen and then choosing **PRINT** or use the “**snipping tool**” on your computer to snip the area you want, and then print



Note: If you want to use “snip” - Search for **snipping tool** in the search engine in the lower left of the computer screen.



6. To find out more about the physiographic zones - **Click on the screen on each zone** to bring up information about the zone - including the fact sheet.



7. Click on “**Download Fact Sheet**” for the detailed information about that zone.
