The 2022 year was tough for farmers and the wider sector. Although farmers benefited from strong global prices for red meat, there was also the ongoing impact of COVID-19, processing constraints, weather events and a tsunami of regulatory reforms.

Many of the policy changes and proposals in the environmental area have been unworkable and we have worked hard on behalf of all farmers to pressure officials and the Government to fix them.

The job isn't done yet. While we secured changes to the winter grazing rules and greater recognition for genuine sequestration, the wholesale conversion of sheep and beef farms into carbon farms continues apace and the Government has still not addressed our concerns about the low slope map, biodiversity or the methane targets.

It's really important all farmers have their say. Please note the deadlines for voting. Internet and postal voting, and proxy forms if required, must be received by the Returning Officer at Electionz.com by **2pm 22 March 2023**.
