Elections

Election Day will be **Friday 18 March 2022**. Elections will be conducted by postal and internet voting.

To be eligible to vote, a livestock farmer must, on 30 June 2021, have owned at least:
250 sheep, or
50 beef cattle, or
100 dairy cattle.

Livestock farmers owning at least the minimum number of livestock in the Central South Island electorate are encouraged to contact B+LNZ on 0800 233 352 to check if they are on the electoral roll or to get a voter registration form.
