Generation Next: Our Futures Sheep and Beef Farmers is a programme designed to nurture, assist and encourage the current and future farmers within our sector.

The technical programme for practical people involves the delivery of three workshops over a six month period with the following objectives:

- Understand the farm business – financial basics and management
- Develop better decision making skills
- Understand technology and genetics within the industry
- Understand the importance of managing mental health and personal wellbeing
- Understand the overall industry goals and aims

60 spaces are available across the South Island and the workshops will be held in early June, August and late November.

- Actively working on a sheep and beef or dry stock property (associated levy payers)
- Aged between 18 and 45 years' old
- Willingness to learn new skills and understand the drivers to improving on farm profitability of the sheep and beef sector
- Goals listed show that plan to stay in the food and fibre sector
- Application shows progression over time through positions or goals represent this
- Farming and living in the area of application
- Available to attend all three days
